

Mr **Avetik Mejlumyan** agrees that part of his experience reports as well as pictures submitted can be used by ifa for public documentation (e.g. on ifa website). ifa should be notified of any media contact beforehand, e.g. planned interviews with the participant. In case of public non-ifa events or interviews, the participant is requested to identify himself as a participant of the CrossCulture Programme, informing about the grant received from ifa.


§ 5 Final stipulations

1. Failure to abide by the regulations of this agreement may lead to withdrawal or termination of the grant. Giving information about personal conditions (e.g. in the application process) that prove to be incorrect or incomplete will also be considered a breach of contract and ifa is entitled to take action. This might evoke severe measures such as informing the participant's employer and the German embassy in **Yerevan**. Eventually, ifa reserves its right to reclaim part of the grant disbursed.
2. A preterm termination of the online professional fellowship will revoke this agreement and exempt ifa from the responsibilities listed above.
3. This agreement is subject to revocation in case ifa does not receive the funds approved in the federal budget (i. e. due to spending freezes or termination of funding by the Federal Foreign Office).
4. Any changes of this agreement must be made in writing and must be agreed upon by all parties. Collateral agreements have not been made.
5. Should parts of this agreement not have legal effect or cease to have legal effect, this will not affect its other legally binding parts.
6. We agreed on Stuttgart as place of performance and as place of jurisdiction.
